The Pacific Marine & Estuarine Fish Habitat Partnership (PMEP) provides West Coast-wide Fish Habitat data products and tools to users with a wide range of data experience, including GIS analysts, biologists, restoration practitioners and policy makers. This project will ensure that PMEP's newly published nearshore fish habitat datasets are shared widely through an easy to use web-based mapping application.
