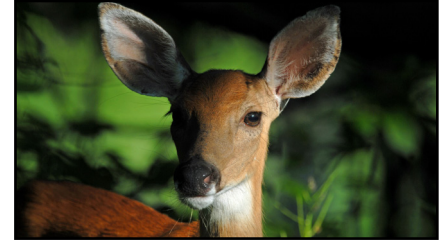
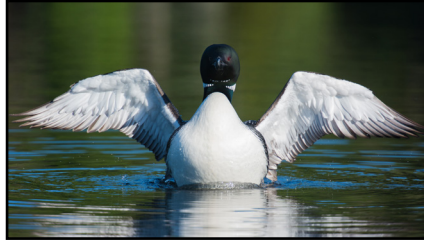


# The Full Reach of Pittman-Robertson Funding in the United States



State fish and wildlife agencies have **OVER 120 GRANTS** that help conserve, monitor, and manage over **500 SPECIES** of wild birds and mammals.



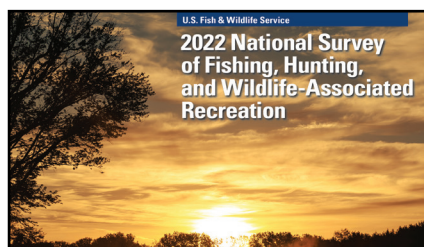
In the United States, over **36 MILLION ACRES** of State Wildlife Management Areas or Game lands are operated and maintained with Pittman-Robertson funding, providing access and opportunities to hunt, trap, fish and connect with nature.



Between 2019 and 2021, Pittman-Robertson grants funded over **134 R3 PROJECTS** across the country.



Since 1987, **16 STATES** have developed **NEARLY 90 PROJECTS** to restore, conserve, and manage black bear populations in the U.S. The earliest PR funded black bear grants began in the 1950's.



Between 2019 and 2021, Pittman-Robertson grants funded over **67 STUDIES** examining public interest in fish and wildlife management, conservation, and participation.
